

### **Annual Enrollment 2026**

Medicare Annual Enrollment Period (AEP) is HERE – October 16 through December 4 Shelby Senior Services, will again this year, partner with Medicare and have SHIP Counselors available to assist you at NO COST. Both in-person and phone-call appointments will be available. Let the volunteer know which is your preference when you call to make your appointment.

IMPORTANT to KNOW to make your appointments run smoothly:

- 1. Schedule your appointment for one hour and be prepared to arrive on time and use the entire hour. One hour per person (not one hour per couple).
- 2. Days available for SHIP appointments begin October 16 and end December 4. Hours are Tuesday Thursday 10:00am-2:00pm.
- 3. Bring your Medicare Card (the red, white, and blue one) and the You Book you received in the mail.
- 4. Bring a complete list of your PRESCRIPTION drugs by name, dosage, and frequency.
- 5. Bring all the cards you use for any of your health care when you see your doctors.
- 6. Know your monthly income to see if you qualify for any subsidies.
- 7. If you do not have the needed materials with you, you will be asked to reschedule your appointment.

How do I schedule with a SHIP Counselor for Medicare AEP?

- 1. Call Shelby Senior Services at 317-398-0127. Inform them that you want to schedule a Medicare Annual Enrollment appointment with a SHIP Counselor.
- 2. If you prefer a phone appointment, this is when you tell them.
- 3. You will be asked: your name, your phone number, and what you are wanting to review. Do you only want to review your prescription drug plan or do you want to review your medical, dental, and/or Advantage Plan, or all of the above?

You will be responsible for remembering your own appointment. You will not be receiving reminder calls prior to your appointment. If you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment, call Shelby Senior Services at 317-398-0127 for assistance.



# **Dwain Alexander**

Dwain Alexander was born on January 11, 1942, in Shelbyville, Indiana. His father worked for Compton Dairy and delivered milk by horse and wagon. He would start out at midnight and cover half of his route. Sometimes when I was four and five, he would come home and pick me up. Then I would go with him on the rest of his route. It was a thrill ride. If you spent too much time at a stop, the horse would go to the next stop. When done, you would unhitch the horse, and it would run up the hill to its stall. The horse's name was Red.

When I was 11 years old, I started passing papers for the Indianapolis Times. I won four contests while passing papers. Went to Washington, D.C. two times, New York, and Niagara Falls. Took money this trip and got \$25. Had three jobs at one time. Passed papers. When I started working, I bought my clothes and school books. I would go to Bob West's clothing store and put clothes in layaway. I would open up a Christmas Club at Shelby National for fifty cents a week. This gave me \$25 to buy Christmas. I went to Addison Township school until 8<sup>th</sup> Grade, where I played basketball, softball and track. I would also set pins in a bowling alley and washed cars on the weekend. My first job in high school was working at Ross' Supermarket until I graduated in 1960. I made \$1 an hour and sometimes worked 80 hours a week. After I graduated, I followed in my father's footsteps and went to work at Compton Dairy. After Compton's, I worked for Standard Grocery for 13 years. Owned Alex's Frost Top until my parents' deceased. Owned Jackets Hive in Morristown for 15 years. Then worked at and retired from Dolly Madison. Went to work at Walmart for 13 years and finally retired.

On June 17, 1961, I married my first wife, Michelle Curtis-Brendan, and we had three children. On January 28, 2023, after 62 years of marriage, she passed away. On July 29, 2024, I married Barbara Hoban. I was working at Walmart when I met her. We had a lot in common, and I fell deeply in love with her. We were the first couple to get married at the senior center. Barb finally convinced me at the age of 83 to finally quit working.




